Objectives of spending PPSG
To continue to improve the provision of PE, Sport and the Adventurous Curriculum at Oakhurst delivered by the specialist PE teacher
To improve the range of quality extra-curricular PE opportunities so that participation is increased
Specialist teacher to assist other teachers with their planning and delivery of PE in lessons
Additional CPD for teachers from Swindon Sports Partnership for all staff for both teachers and HLTA staff where it is identified
Promote PE activities accessed by the physically impaired children
Purchase appropriate equipment to support teachers after undertaking CPD
Purchase bikes/trikes for the Early Years Team to promote gross motor development

Sports Week	£3,668	All Oakhurst children to receive a week of summer sports. Up to 15 alternative sports to be coached throughout the school week from external coaching organisations.
Fortius PE package	£500	Oakhurst purchase Swindon Schools Partnership package so we can enter all competitions and access SSP website for resources and CPD
Equipment	£2,610	New, replaced and replenished equipment.
Dance provision (2Step Dance)	£475	Dance provision for EY, KS1 and KS2

Minibus usage/running costs	£600	Intra school competitions SEN children transported to various activities
Grounds	£500	Sand, soil for long jump pit and pot holes on field to be filled throughout the year. Line markings for football pitches and athletics tracks.
Martial Arts	£400	Martial Arts provision for EY, KS1 & KS2
PE Specialist	£1,502	Teachers to work with specialist PE teacher to up-skill their planning and delivery of PE Oakhurst to enter every competition organised by the Swindon School Partnership Specialist to organise festivals with other schools so percentage of children who represent the school rises.

Impact of using PPSG 2016-17

All children access specialist PE teaching on a regular basis

All children in Reception to Y6 access outdoor learning activities

All children in Year 4, 5 and 6 have the opportunity to attend a residential visit (very few children do not take up this opportunity).

National 'Gold' Kitemark award for attending all local competitions and participation in sporting after school clubs.

Swindon cross country champions, central league football champions, dodgeball champions, hockey champions, boccia champions and quad kids champions (Y2).

60 children performing at the Swindon Dance Festival at the Wyvern Theatre after attending our after school club and dance provision (2Step dance academy).

50+ children per day attending sporting after school clubs.

New equipment being accessed throughout the school day enriching the curriculum for all. This has also allowed us to create more inter-school competition.

All children at Oakhurst have experienced 'Oakhurst Sports Week' and have been introduced to array of new sports.
